

# Lesson 3 Who is Jesus?

This is perhaps one of the most combatted and controversial topics there are in terms of religions today – Who is Jesus? Is He a regular man? Just a Prophet? A lunatic? The son of God? God in the Flesh? We must investigate what the bible says about Jesus and who He is to find out.

## Jesus was a man:

- He was born (Luke 2:7).
- He grew in stature and wisdom (Luke 2:52).
- He got tired and thirsty (John 4:6 / John 19:28).
- He had human emotions (John 12:27 / Matthew 26:38 / John 11:35).
- He died (Luke 23:46).
- He had a real human body after His resurrection (Luke 24:39 / John 20:20, 27).

## Jesus is God:

## John 8:58 | Jesus existed before Abraham.

<sup>58</sup> Jesus said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, before Abraham was, I AM"

## John 10:30 and John 5:17-18 | Jesus is equal with the Father.

<sup>30</sup> I and My Father are one. <sup>17</sup> But Jesus answered them, "My Father has been working until now, and I have been working." <sup>18</sup> Therefore the Jews sought all the more to kill Him, because He not only broke the Sabbath, but also said that God was His Father, making Himself equal with God.

## Mark 2:5-7 | Jesus forgave sins, something only God can do.

<sup>5</sup> When Jesus saw their faith, He said to the paralytic, "Son, your sins are forgiven you." <sup>6</sup> And some of the scribes were sitting there and reasoning in their hearts, <sup>7</sup> "Why does this Man speak blasphemies like this? Who can forgive sins but God alone?"

# John 5:18 | Jesus' critics verified that Jesus claimed to be God.

<sup>18</sup> Therefore, the Jews sought all the more to kill Him, because He not only broke the Sabbath, but also said that God was His Father, making Himself equal with God.

## John 1:1-3, 14 | Jesus is the Creator

<sup>1</sup> In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. <sup>2</sup> He was in the beginning with God. <sup>3</sup> All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made. <sup>14</sup> And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.

# Exodus 3:14 | God revealed Himself as "I AM" to Moses.

<sup>14</sup> And God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM." And He said, "Thus you shall say to the children of Israel, 'I AM has sent me to you."
